Artist Statement

Resembling the “Fire Tetrahedron” the work reflects the purposes of the Cambie Fire Hall No. 3 and Richmond North Ambulance Station and its relationship to the community it serves. The work stands near the sidewalk, providing easy public access and inviting an interactive engagement and the ability to push the work is slowly discovered by those who use the area. The work is literal in presenting the services named and the community served; it is metaphoric in giving vision to the interlinked and interdependent relationships among Richmond Fire-Rescue, BC Ambulance Service, and the broader community.

Description

This work is comprised of three interleaved/interlocked triangular panels standing on a raised circular platform near the northeast corner of the building. The three panels form a three-sided pyramidal form, each perforated with water-jet cut text: FIRE-RESCUE, AMBULANCE and COMMUNITY.
